Documents are also available for viewing at the Lincoln Builders Bureau, Omaha Builders Exchange, Kearney Builders Bureau, Hastings Chamber of Commerce, and Builders Plan Service in Grand Island.

Project Description: Work includes building renovation and site work at the Kearney West Bound Rest Area

(mile marker 271 west bound) and Kearney East Bound Rest Area (mile marker 267 west bound) along Interstate 80. Site work includes removal and replacement of concrete walks, including grading and new ADA signage to identify accessible routes. Building renovation work includes removal and replacement of toilet accessories and partitions, replacing selected plumbing fixtures, tile work and relocating incidental electrical work.

All bids shall be made on the printed proposal forms attached to and made a part of the Proposed Contract Documents and submitted in a sealed envelope marked "AFE W-002 – KEARNEY REST AREA ADA PROJECT". Bids which are mailed shall be placed in a separate sealed envelope, labeled as described in this paragraph, inside the mailing envelope
